

Divider Rails

- A divider rail is an extra rail in the middle of the panel.
- Creates two sections in the panel so louvers can be operated independently.
- Strengthens the panel and enhances structural integrity.
- Required for panel heights over 74".

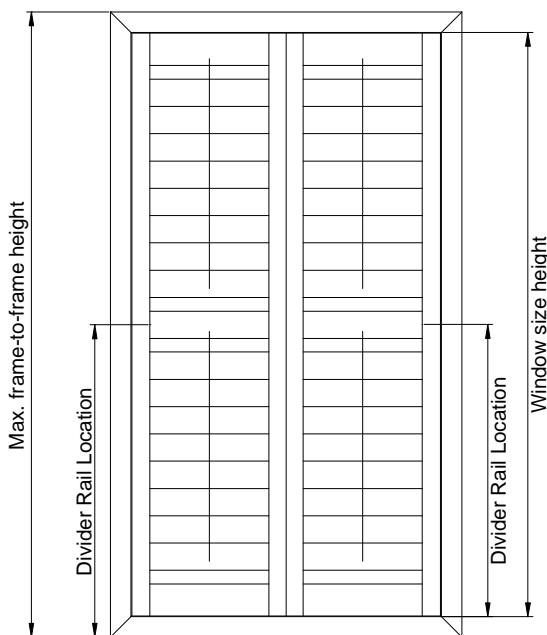
Specifications

- Standard width: 3"
- Default location: center of the panel unless specified otherwise

Measurements:

- Window size:
 - Measure from the bottom of the window to the center of the divider rail.
- Max frame-to-frame:
 - Measure from the bottom of the frame to the center of the divider rail.
- Position:
 - Per customer's specification. However, the divider rail may be adjusted to a lower or higher position, within our allowable deviation, to ensure reinforcement and aesthetics of the shutter.

When placing the order, please clearly specify if the divider rail position needs to line up with that of other shutter divider rails in the same room. Please also refer to the table below for the allowable deviation details.



Divider rail allowable deviations

Louver Size	Allowable ± Deviation
1 ⁷ / ₈ "	³ / ₄ "
2 ¹ / ₂ "	1"
3 ¹ / ₂ "	1 ¹ / ₂ "
4 ¹ / ₂ "	2"
